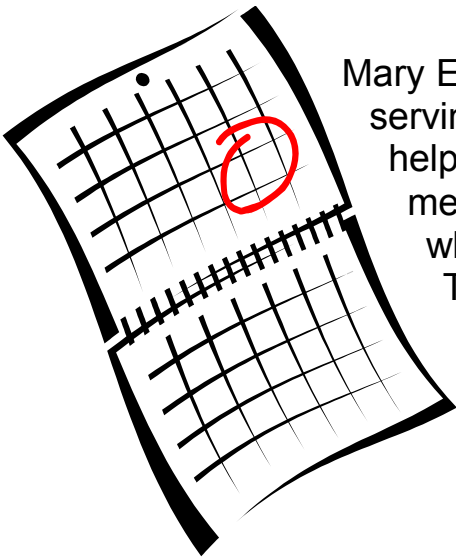


Adopt A Day!
